From Pastor Kent's Desk

When I was growing up, I always assumed that everyone around me had at least a basic understanding of Jesus' teaching. Not so anymore! That's why it's essential for us as followers of "The Way" to be prepared to share our faith with others when the opportunity arises. It's our "calling."

"Wait a minute," you say, "I'm not called to share the Gospel!" The truth is, we all are. It comes with the territory. Each and every baptized Christian has the privilege of being an ambassador for Christ. Sharing the faith should be a natural outgrowth of having a faith. If the early church hadn't shared the faith, we wouldn't be here today! It's incumbent upon each generation to share the faith with the succeeding one. Rather than being reticent to talk openly about the person of Jesus, we should be thrilled to share the "Good News" with anyone who is open to hearing it! In fact, that's one of the teachings of Jesus we'll be covering in the weeks ahead. (Funny how that works!)

So, I invite you to prepare yourselves for these sermons by reading the passages I'll be using ahead of time. That way, we'll literally all be on the same page! February 2: Matthew 5:1-12; February 9: Matthew 5:13-20; February 16: Matthew 5:21-37. We'll finish-up the month with Transfiguration Sunday, February 23: Matthew 17:1-9. I look forward to sharing the words of Jesus with you!


